Another Man-Woman Monster.—Circumstances have come to light which have caused no little talk, and occasioned surmises among the people of Waterford. As nearly as we have been able to collect, they are as follows:—A man named Rollis died on Tuesday week, and on the following Friday a person, to whom he had been married upwards of twenty years, died also. This creature had been for years in the habit of going out as charwoman to several respectable families in the town, and in many instances has attended women at their delivery.
