SHE POSED AS A MAN.

Drank, Smoked, Gambled and Swore Like Her Rough Mates.

MILWAUKEE, July 14 — A simple arrest by the police on a dispatch from the Fon Du Lac authorities has brought out quite a romantic story. Chief Jansen arrested one Frank Blunt, who was wanted at Fon Du Lac on a charge of grand larceny. The search developed the fact that Frank Blunt was a woman. For fifteen years "Frank" had dressed and acted as a man, drinking, smoking, gambling and swearing with the rough crowd in which her life was passed, and not once was her identity discovered.

She is a native of Nova Scotia named Annie Morris. Her family lived in Halifax, N. S. Annie fourteen years ago ran away, accompanied by her brother, who was two years younger. She was at that time 13 years of age. The mother of the children was dead and the cruelties of the father, the girl says, caused them to leave home. Annie put on a suit of her brother's clothes and from that time until now has passed as a man.
