## we're having a party!

Planning began before anyone left the last one. Everyone had such a good time that we wanted to find out what made it work so well, so here is part of the list we came up with:

- everyone loved being dressed for three days.
- \* everyone loved being with so many people who understand cross-dressers.
- everyone loved the freedom and the absence of serious meetings.
- \* everyone loved the warm Texas weather.
- you must have liked the boutique because all the vendors were happy.
- you liked having the beauticians, makeup people, manicurist, and photographer.
- you liked the day tour of the city
- \* most of all, you loved meeting the other cross-dressers and their wives.

Our plans for 1990 include all those things that you liked in 1989, plus a few additions.
